The Lake Township September regular meeting was held on Monday, September 10, 2018 at the Lake Township Municipal Building.

Present were Supervisors Jon Gander, Fred Elder and Harry Fairlamb along with Secretary Deanna Yarnell.

Chairman Elder opened the meeting at 8:00p.m. Minutes to the August regular meeting were read and approved by a **motion** from Elder, 2nd by Fairlamb.

Guests: Stefania Janus, Wendy Kellogg and Mary Andrews from the Lakeview Area Library

Chairman Elder recognized guest Stefania Janus who is concerned about the activity going on at the rental property next door to her. Mrs. Janus brought up several violations to the Garbage/Junk Ordinance by the renters and land owner at 445 Stoneboro Lateral Road, Stoneboro, Pa 16153. In addition to the violations of excess garbage and multiple junk cars on the property she believes that there maybe illegal activity going on there as well. Mrs. Janus' quality of life is severely suffering with the current situation going on next door in addition to her quality of life Mrs. Janus is in fear for her safety. The Supervisors said that they would contact the authorities about the suspected illegal activity. A copy of the Ordinance was given to Mrs. Janus and the Supervisors wanted her to know that the Township Solicitor is currently reviewing the Ordinance to see if it applies to these issues. Mr. Louis Dinicola, the land owner will be notified by the Solicitor pending his findings. Mrs. Yarnell updated the contact information for Mrs. Janus and the Supervisors assured her that they will do what they can to help.

Wendy Kellogg presented the Supervisors with a financial packet from the Lakeview Area Library and informed them of all the exciting things happening at the Library. The Library is currently in the process of moving from their current location to 3265 Main Street, Sandy Lake. In their new building they hope to increase their visibility in the community and provide more services to them as well. As a thank you for the financial support of the Library all Lake Township residence will be eligible for a free \$15.00 single or family one year membership.

The Township currently has 21 active members. Mrs. Kellogg expressed the need for continued support from Municipalities and wanted the Supervisors to know how much their donation was appreciated. The Supervisors thanked Mrs. Kellogg for all her hard work and that they would be continuing to support the Library. They also suggested that information be put on the new Township web site about the Library and a possible link to create awareness to the programs being offered.
