The Lake Township October regular meeting was held on Monday, October 08, 2018 at the Lake Township Municipal Building.

*Present were Supervisors Jon Gander, Fred Elder and Harry Fairlamb along with Secretary Deanna Yarnell.

*Chairman Elder opened the meeting at 8:00p.m. Minutes to the September regular meeting were read and approved by a **motion** from Gander, 2nd by Fairlamb.

The Supervisors worked on a proposed budget for 2019. After an agreement on a proposed budget Supervisor Gander **motioned** to advertise the proposed budget to be adopted at the November regular meeting. This would include no changes to millage or per capita. 2nd by Fairlamb.

Additional attempts to have a meeting set up with Jim Barrish to get the specs on the remaining baseball field at the Jack Jones Memorial Complex have been tried with no success. In addition to setting up another meeting the Supervisors would also like him to be informed of the upcoming fence project and donation of a storage shed by FLEX-O-SPAN as they have delayed the fence project already. A brief discussion was had as to what could be done to enforce the Junk Ordinance at the property on the Stoneboro Lateral Road owned by Lou Dinacola. The Supervisors would like the Solicitor to send him a letter informing him of the issues violating the ordinance in hopes that no further action will be needed.

Secretary Report:

- Jon Wilson has completed and approved the State Fund project for 2018. He cited that the addition to the project that was not advertised must be reimbursed from the General Fund back to the State Fund. This reimbursement is being presented in tonight's bills. While in our area he saw the tree trimming that was done on McCormick Road and thought that it was a great project and would like to see more of that. He asked about Mower Tree Service and wants to know if the Township would be interested in doing a joint Tree Trimming Bid like the Tar and Chip currently done with the Delaware COG.

Roadmaster Report:

- Mower Tree Service is done. (Supervisors are very pleased with the project.)
- Back-up on road sides has begun by Sonntag Excavating
