## Treasurer Report:

- General Fund \$ 26,726.20

The Supervisors had a discussion about putting a bid package together to open at next month's meeting. Mr. Elder had questions about financing and asked that information be gotten on various options for loans. With the understanding that the money in the General Savings would be used to purchase the Grader. The current Township Grader needs repair and parts are no longer available for it, making it difficult to repair, if not impossible. Fred Elder **motioned** to advertise a 32,000 SAE 2010 or newer. Bids to be opened at the May meeting. Gander 2nd.

## Secretary Report:

- The MCSB State Savings account has been transferred to the MCSB State Checking. Due to the amount of paperwork needed by MCSB to wire the money into our new PLGIT State Fund account PLGIT has sent deposit slips and information as to just write a

check to transfer the funds. Once the funds are transferred, both the MCSB Savings and Checking accounts will be closed.

- The Lakeview Little League has expressed interest in renting the fields at JJMC. They will only be interested if Mr. Barrish is not involved due to the contentious nature of the relationship with LARA and the Little League. The Township Supervisors just want the projects to move forward and for the area children to use the complex as intended.
- George Ely and Associates in Carlisle, PA have been contacted for a quote on a Pavilion/Restroom/Concession Stand to give the Supervisors an idea of the amount of money needed to do a project at the Jack Jones Memorial Complex.

**Roadmaster Report:**

- Sink hole on Doyle Road has been fixed, work on Colson Road culvert will start this week
- E. Zahniser Road needs a culvert replacement, a sink hole is developing
- Ditches have been cleaned
- Trees have been cut and removed from various
