The Lake Township regular meeting was held on Monday, April 11, 2022, at the Lake Township Municipal Building.

*Present were Supervisors Jon Gander, Harry Fairlamb and Secretary Deanna Yarnell.

*Vice Chairman opened the meeting at 8:00p.m. Minutes to the March regular meeting were read and approved by a **motion** from Fairlamb, 2nd by Gander.

Vice Chairman Fairlamb recognized guest Bobby McChesney. Ms. McChesney stated that she is in the process of buying property in Lake Township. She is working with the VA to secure a loan and is in need of a letter stating that solar is allowed as the primary electric source and has a pit privy. She also asked about local contractors and general information about the area. The Supervisors welcomed her to the area and provided several names of local haulers who could possibly help. Mrs. Yarnell will send her a letter to present to the VA.

Guest Dave Hoobler from H & H Material requested permission to build up the side of Canon Road by the lake bringing the roadside up 30 inches above water level. A culvert will be needed and a map of the purposed build up was provided (see file). This safety measure will be done by H&H Material if allowed.

Supervisor Fairlamb **Motioned** to allow H & H Material to build up the roadside on Canon Road 30 inches above water level. This will start H & H Material and end at the bridge on Cannon Road, 2nd by Gander.

The Supervisors have concerns about the bid package that PennDot representative Jon Wilson has helped write for the SuperPav on Strausser Road. **Motion** from Gander to ad a scratch coat to the bid to be opened next month 2nd by Fairlamb.

Bills were approved and paid.
