Minutes were read and approved by a **motion** from Fairlamb 2nd by Elder

Supervisor Elder recognized guest Stephanie Jones. Ms. Jones brought 2 grant applications for the Jack Jones Memorial Ballfield. She has been in contact with the DCNR about the original grant and was told phase 1 was complete, however now additional grants were ever submitted for phase 2 and 3. The DCNR grant is a 50/50 match. The other grant from the Pittsburgh Pirates now includes applicants from Mercer County. Secretary Yarnell will work with all parties and submit grant applications on behalf of the Township.
