The Lake Township regular meeting was held on Monday, June 8, 2026, at the Lake Township Municipal building.

Present where Supervisors Fred Elder, Harry Fairlamb, Jon Gander and Secretary Deanna Yarnell

Guests: Doniele Russell and Rosalyn Reagle from MCRPC

Chairman Elder opened the meeting at 8:00 pm

Guest Rosalyn Reagle was recognized by Chairman Elder. She stated that she came from the New Vernon Township meeting and they did not sign the new Resolution and Exhibits. Stating that they do not have any funds to put toward the grant and want to have a road maintenance agreement in place prior to signing the Resolution. Secretary Yarnell was stunned as she was prepared to start submitting the grant application this month to beat the July 31st deadline. She also didn't understand their hesitation as they have already signed two previous versions already and have submitted a letter of support for the project. She stated that she did send New Vernon a bill for half of the engineer work for the Stormwater addition and the engineer's mileage for attending the meeting at the Township with both Township Supervisors, the Planning Commission, PennDOT and representatives from H&H Material in the amount of \$281.44 for the Stormwater planning and hoped that was not an issue. Ms. Reagle assured Secretary Yarnell that she would have time to submit after the July meeting and that she would be available to help if needed. Ms. Russell stated that she would reach out to the DCED Multimodal contact and see what Lake Township could do if New Vernon refused to sign. Secretary Yarnell stated that she would reach out to New Vernon to see if there are any questions she could answer to help them sign. Secretary Yarnell stated that this is the third year of applying and they have agreed twice before with no issues. That a lot of time from both her and the Planning Commission has gone into this application and would like to see it move forward.

Minutes to the May regular and May special meetings were read and approved by a **motion** from Fairlamb 2nd by Elder

Motion to approve Exhibits 1-10 for the Multimodal Grant application by Elder 2nd by Fairlamb

Resolution 2026-05 authorizing the submission of a Multimodal Transportation Fund Grant application to the Commonwealth Financing Authority (CFA) for the Billy Boyd – Canon Road Improvement project in the amount of \$2,157,623.00 approved by a **motion** from Gander 2nd by Fairlamb

Resolution 2026-05 replaces Resolution 2026-04 noting the joint application with New Vernon Township. Lake Township plans on moving forward with the grant application with or without New Vernon Township and hopes New Vernon Township's reservations can be answered by the July 13th regular meeting to sign their

resolution.

Motion to purchase one load of brine approximately 4800 gal from Seneca Mineral at .52 a gal. to be spread on Vernon, North Vernon and possible South Vernon roads as far as the truck load will cover by Fairlamb 2nd by Elder.

The Supervisors had a discussion to include the District Road cemetery in next year's mowing bid as Jonathan has mowed as an employee for the last several years, he is not able to work at the Township as in the past. He has agreed, however, to do the mowing as no one else would take it on.

Motion to pay Jonathan Schiestle \$60.00 per mowing of the Township cemetery on District Road by Fairlamb 2nd by Gander.
